- Meetings were held at her house.
- On 27 Sep 1994 the first trip to the Church of Christ of LDS Family History in Salt Lake City.
- Annual trips to Salt Lake City continued for years.
- In May 1996 a trip to Nashville for NGS Conference.

Mary Collie Cooper (1921-2003) Served as President from 1990-2001



- Served as President for 4 years.
- Meetings moved to the College Station Utility Center.
- In Sep 2003 Mary Collie Cooper died.
- Annual trips to Salt Lake City continued.
- In Aug 2004 created first Bylaws.
- In Feb 2005 incorporated as non-profit. Name "officially" changed to Texas Research Ramblers Genealogy Society.
- New SIGs: Genealogy Computer User
 Group (created by Rod & Frances
 Martin), Rambler Writers, & Roots
 Magic Users.

Bill Lay Served as President from 2001-2005



- Served as President for 2 years.
- Research Comm. continued with recording Brazos Co cemetery recordings and put on website.
- Began transcribing the 1870 US Census for Brazos County.
- Education Comm held DNA workshops.
- Jan 2007 meetings moved to the College Station Prof Bldg.
- Annual trips to Salt Lake City, Clayton & Conroe continued.

Dan Castillo Served as President from 2005-2007




- Served as President for 2 years.

 & Conroe continued.


Jane Horn Served as President from 2009-2011

- Annual trips to Salt Lake City continued.


Henry Hanson Served as President from 2011-2013

- Sep 2014 membership peaked with 170 members.

Sheila May / Henry Hanson Served as President from 2013-2015




- Served as President for 2 years.
